I went for the classic Friday dish, it is Fry-yay after all: a delectable Inch's Cider Battered Fish 'n' Chips. With minted peas on the side and the tartare sauce, served quaintly in a sweet enamel cup and the vinegar was served in a potion like little bottle which left me smiling from ear to ear. The fish was a masterpiece—delicate, flaky, and wrapped in a crisp batter that melted delightfully in the mouth.

We rounded off our meal with desserts to remember: a heavenly sticky toffee pudding with ice cream and a banoffee pudding cup—both simply divine.

As we were leaving, a cute bowl of freshly cut asparagus caught our eye, available for sale. Unable to resist, we bought a couple of bunches and can now confirm, after cooking it at home—it was delicious. A perfect touch and finish to our evening.

But it's not just the food that makes The Packhorse the heart of Northborough—it's also a hub of excitement with themed nights, quizzes, and live music offering endless entertainment. I'm already planning a return trip for their afternoon tea with Charly.
